Dear Mr. Watson,

I am writing to express my concern regarding a proposal to extend the contract of your current waste collection provider without a competitive procurement process.

I understand city leaders are considering a contract extension with Waste Connections, despite there being more than five years of life remaining on Waste Connections' existing agreement with the city. I also understand you have been led to believe by your current provider that a competitive bidding process would result in an increase to your current rates.

To the contrary, I can cite numerous instances of late where local governments' rates for waste collection service were dramatically reduced as a result of a procurement process. As a reference, I have attached a list of these examples.

Secondly, I don't understand why the city is in such a hurry to extend a contract when there's more than five years remaining on the existing agreement. If you talk to local officials in Soddy Daisy, Madisonville, Cleveland and Tellico Village, they will confirm a procurement process substantially lowered disposal rates for their constituents.
